

NCSL Registration Information – St. Christopher

St. Christopher School is a proud participant in the Neumann Catholic Swim League. Our season begins in September and ends in November with a Championship Meet at UB Alumni Arena.

AGE GROUPS:

Our team has three age groups (age as of September 1, 2018):

8 and under

9 & 10

11 and older

TRY-OUTS and QUALIFICATIONS:

Tryouts for the team will be held at the first practice on September 6, 2018 at Tonawanda High School. In order to qualify for the team, the swimmer **MUST** be able to swim one length of the pool (25 yards) continuously and without any assistance.

WEEKLY COMMITMENTS:

Throughout the swim season, there will be two practices a week and a team meet on Sunday. Attendance at practices and the weekly swim meets are **REQUIRED** in order to be on the team.

****HEALTH PHYSICAL FORM:****

Each swimmer must have an up to date health physical form to submit in order to participate on the swim team. No swimmer will be allowed to practice until the school nurse has verified this information is on file.

- A hard copy of the form must be submitted during registration, even if it is already on file with St. Christopher School.

FEES:

Swim team fees cover the league fees as established by the NCSL as well as other swim related miscellaneous costs. The 2018 swim fees as assessed per family and are as follows:

- o \$85 – One child
- o \$130 – Two children
- o \$165 – Three children
- o \$200 – Four or more children

3. Write a check for the fees as indicated on this information sheet made out to “St. Christopher School”.
4. Submit complete registration (registration form, physical form, check) to St. Christopher and submit it to the school office by 9/7/18

Volunteer Position	Details	Interest?
Coach*	Work on a team of coaches to help guide and develop swimmers.	
Official**	Act as an impartial judge of the competition. Responsible for the effective functioning of the meet to ensure the participants are provided with a quality-swimming environment.	
Scorer**	Act as team representative to assist in tallying scores and overall meet results.	
Timer	Act as a timing official to ensure accurate times are recorded for each swim.	
Lifeguard**	Certified lifeguards are needed for ensuring safety during team practices. Must have current lifeguard certification on file with the NCSL.	

*Coaches must be VIRTUS trained in order to assist with the swim team. **Some positions may require pre-season training session attendance.
