Social Studies 7:

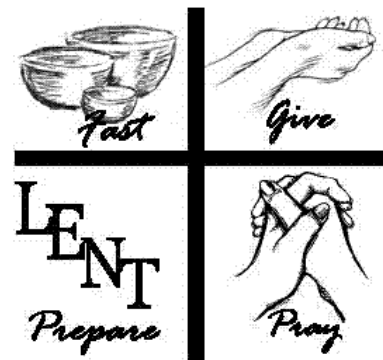
