### Math 7:

We have finished the chapter and students have been given their study guides to begin preparing for the test. This week we will review transformations and work on the study guide in class.

### Math 8:

We continue to work with quadratic equations this week. Students now know 4 different ways to solve quadratic functions and we will spend this week working on all 4 of these options. The 4 options are: Graphing, Factoring, Quadratic Formula, and Complete the Square.

### Math 9:

We worked last week on Measures of central tendency and on making frequency histograms and cumulative frequency histograms. We have officially completed all topics that students need to know for the regents exam and will be working out of the green review books for the remainder of the year. I will be assigning either a part 1 or part 2 from this book as homework each night (including weekends) and will be giving short quizzes throughout the next several weeks that cover all material that students are expected to know for the regents exam.
