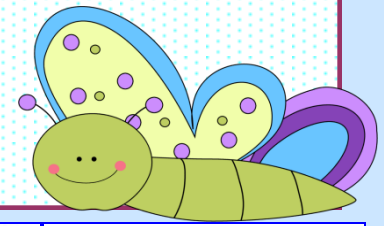


# St. Christopher School Family Information—May 15, 2019
